Demonstration of the 'Collarum' in operation, how it works, assembly, setting, location and baiting, delegates will have the opportunity to set the device.

Traditional Fox Snaring - Types of snares, location, snare setting, stops, anchoring methods and non-targets.

Methods of drawing Foxes away from sensitive areas and entanglement risks, through the use of baiting and slider systems

Demonstration of making a Fox snare from the raw materials to the finished item,

Use of Bait and Lure for Foxes,
